

## *Message from Crest Nicholson*

### HUNTS GROVE UPDATE NOVEMBER 2025



Dear residents,

Work on the primary Hunts Grove access (A38 junction) remains on track for completion by Friday, 19 December 2025 (with full opening the following day). However, as previously explained, a number of unforeseen but essential works have had to be added to the schedule during the course of this project – including foundation reinforcements, drainage, the upgrade of traffic light cabling, etc.

We now need to make some alterations to the central reservation. To do this safely without impacting the reopening date, and after consulting GCC Highways and National Highways, we are organising a night closure of the A38, in both directions between Cross Keys and Waterwells roundabouts:

- Thursday, 25 November 2025
- 11pm - 5am

This is in addition to the night closures previously announced for the final surfacing work on the same stretch of road:

- Monday, 8 December to Friday, 12 December 2025
- 8pm - 6am

With contingency dates of:

- Monday, 15 December and Tuesday, 16 December 2025
- 8pm - 6am

Diversion routes throughout these works will be clearly signed. We kindly ask that drivers follow these directions and refrain from using smaller roads. Pound Lane and Church Lane in Hardwicke will have manned gates to restrict access to residents only. Businesses at Quedgeley West Business Park will be notified about traffic escort arrangements.
